# CAROL ELLIS

LITTLE SALT

Carol Ellis is one of those rare individuals they call a Florida Native. She was Born Carol Ann Salzlein in Ft. Lauderdale, where she grew up on the Isles of East Las Olas. From Ft. Lauderdale she embarked upon sailing voyages across the Atlantic on the schooner Yacht America. Five years and nearly 50,000 nautical miles later, Carol was warmly welcomed to Ocean Reef by members of the family who commissioned the yacht on which she sailed. Carol had no doubt in her mind, Ocean Reef she would call her home port. Her nickname "Little Salt" comes from the time when people were having a hard time pronouncing her last name. What's in a name? The translation of Salzlein (Salz - Salt Lein - Little). Just call me Little Salt.

Carol has been living and working in Ocean Reef since 1984; longer if you include when the EH Ellis family arrived at Ocean Reef back in the 1960s. For the first 17 years of her career at Ocean Reef, Carol was involved in fitness, working at the ORC Tennis Pro Shop and as Club Manager of The Health and Tennis Club. Her passion for photography eventually became a full-time career as an event and wedding photographer, and family portrait artist.

Carol's earliest memories are of pristine waters and unspoiled open spaces of the real Florida. Carol is focused on "at-risk" natural areas, much like the fragile environment that surrounds Ocean Reef. In 1999 she was recognized by then Florida Gov. Jeb Bush for her photographs documenting "Fisheating Creek" at the moment it transferred from private hands to the people in his "Forever Florida" initiative.

Closer to home, Carol finds endless inspiration around Ocean Reef, near the water and in her garden. Her work is prominently on view at Gianni's Ristorante, The Spa at Ocean Reef, the Ocean Reef Cultural Center, and in residences of Ocean Reef members here and afar.
